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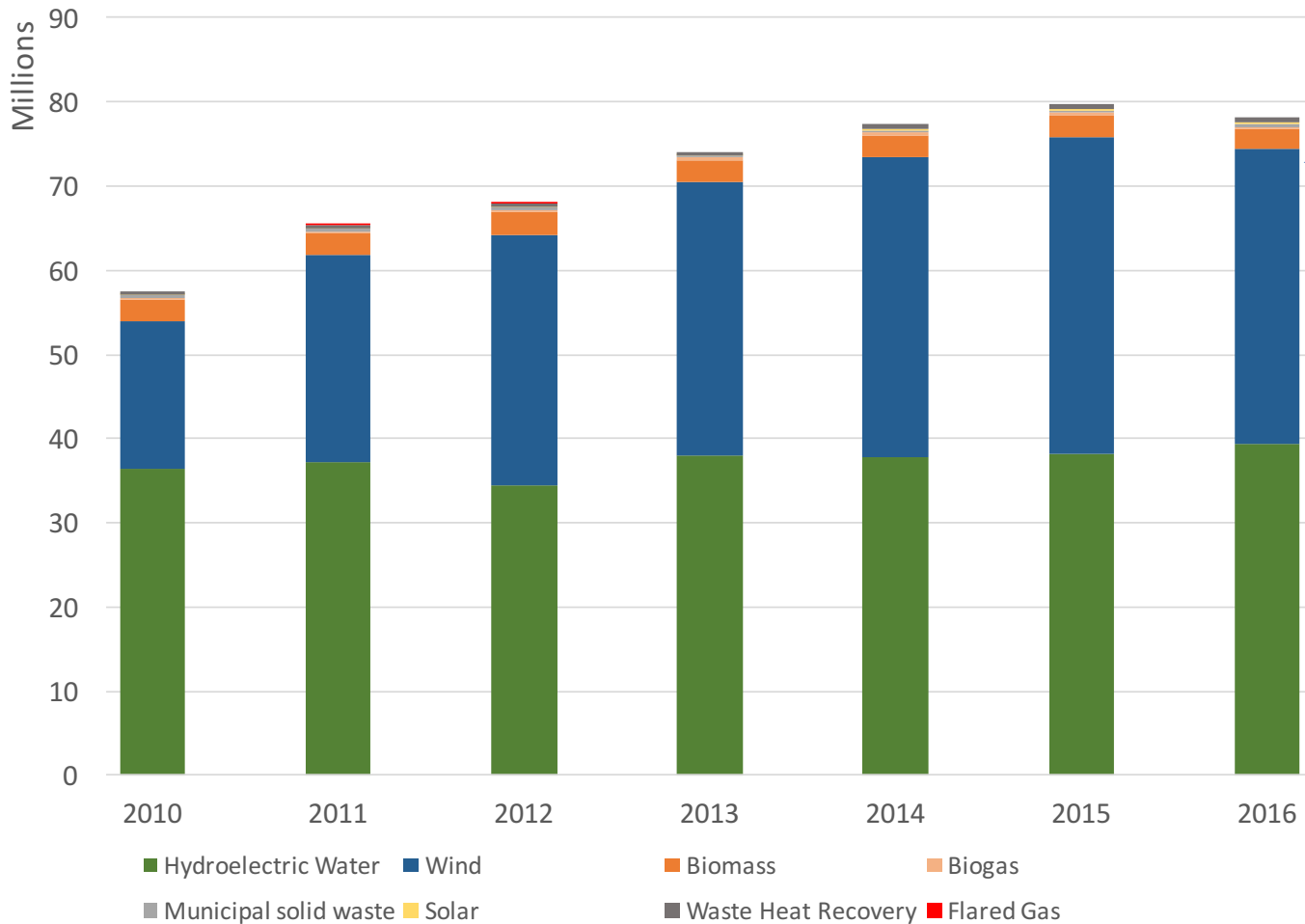

Operations Report

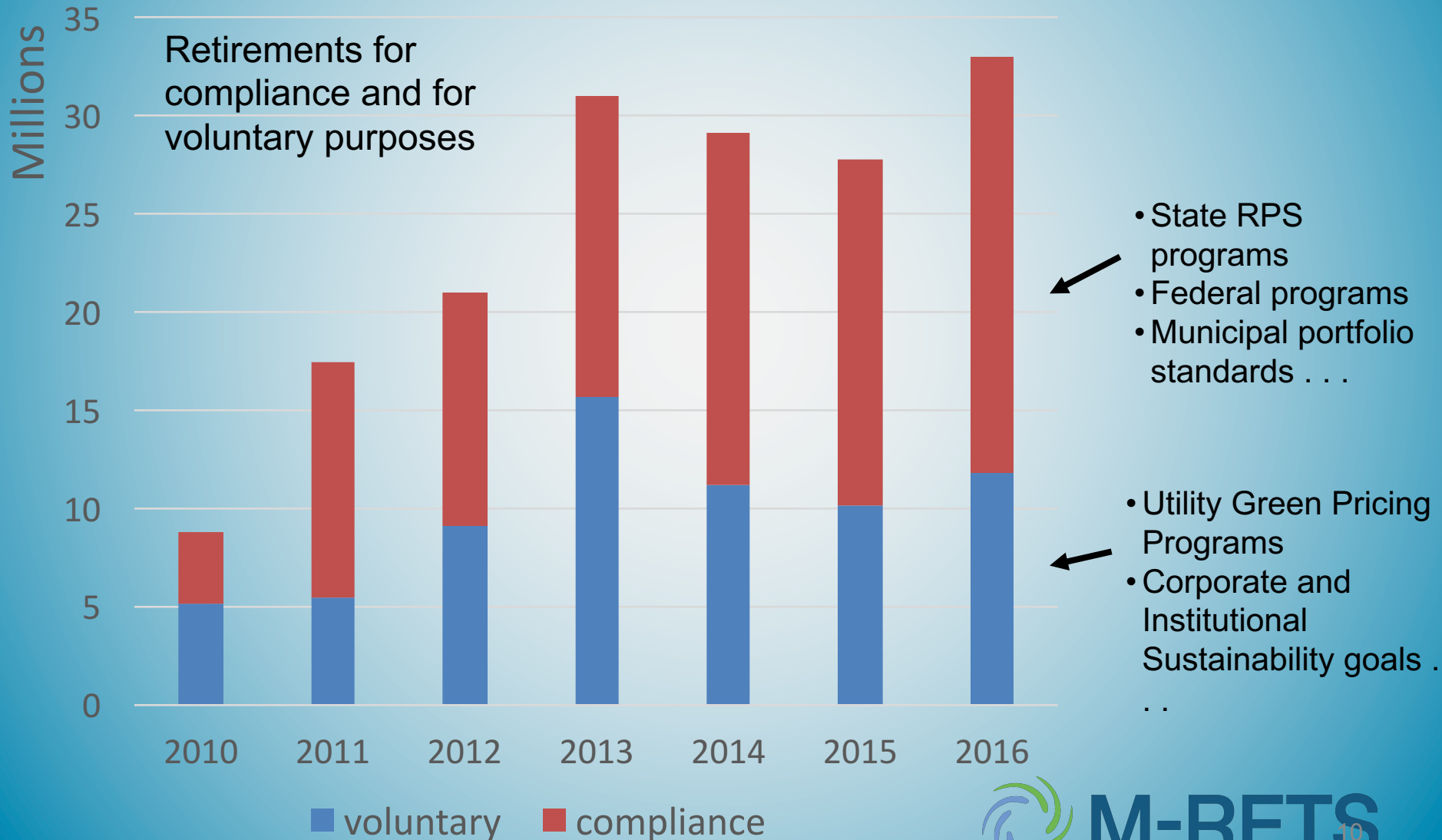
- Fall in-person event was a success with follow on “Trending Green” event on corporate renewable procurement for subscribers and other interested stakeholders.

Reporting window still open for late 2016, on track for surpassing 2015 issuance.



 - NAR Imports Failed to Post Invoice
 - M-RETS - Generators Public Report cannot be filtered for projects with < or >
 - MISO Data Loading Module will not accept file formats containing Underscores



- MN is holding a final meeting to record the takeaways from the stakeholder process, otherwise all efforts are on hold.

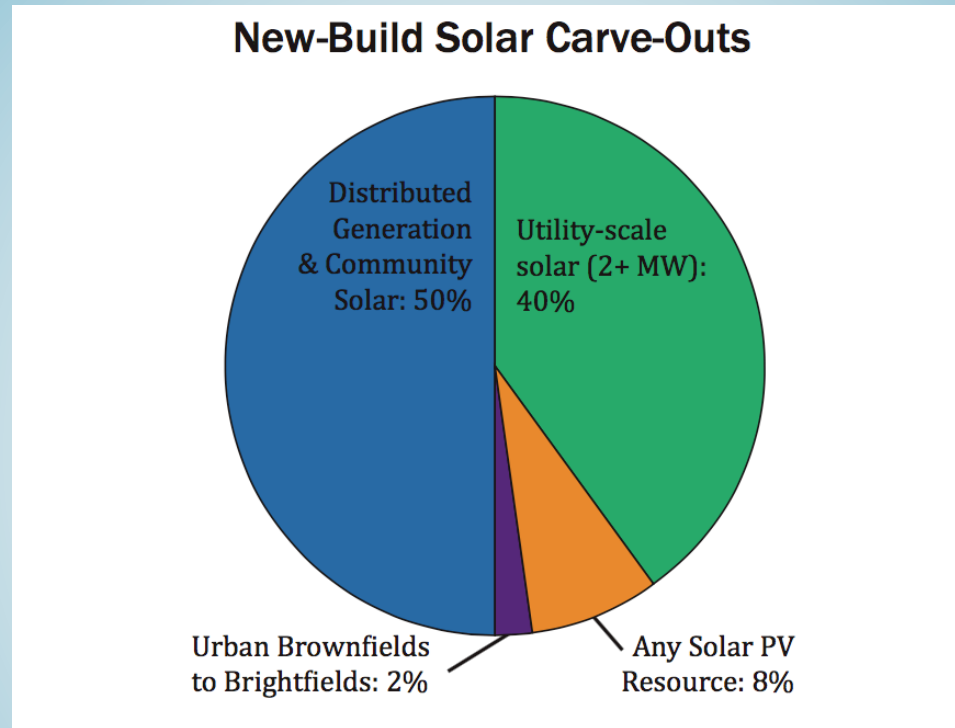
Policy Updates -Illinois SB 2814

- Significant update to the Illinois Renewable Energy Standard
- We are working with regulators to identify necessary changes/enhancements to M-RETS.
- Please contact us (as some of you have) with any questions or concerns.

IL SB 2814 – High Level Summary

- \$235M in annual ratepayer subsidies to nuclear power plants for 13 years.
- Retains the current 25% by 2025 RPS with 2% cost cap on rates, but some changes in provisions.
- Retail net metering rates maintained up to the existing 5% cap – stakeholder process to be implemented to determine rate above cap.
- Updates to Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard.

RPS Changes



- Requirements for certain types of solar
- IPA is directed to create an Adjustable Block Program for DG procurement with schedules of prices for certain quantities.

IL SB 2814 – Issues We Are Following

- Exclusion of RECs from rate-regulated facilities
- Zero Emissions Credits (ZECs)
- Carve-outs for specific types of renewable projects. Are new flags needed?

Other Policy Updates

- Canada:
 - Canada wide price on carbon
 - Alberta – 30% RES by 2030
 - Saskatchewan – 50% RES by 2030
